

## Lively Landscape Quilts Workshop Supply List

### Each participant needs to bring:

- Light table
- Freezer paper, approx. 18" x 24"
- A collection of fabrics (nothing bigger than a fat quarter) in every color of the color wheel. Bring lights, mediums, darks, vibrant, muted, & pastel hues. Bring extra fabrics to go with elements of your particular composition
- 1 fat quarter fabric for backing
- 1 fat quarter thin, white muslin
- tulle, at least 15" x 24"
- a piece of batting approx. 15" x 24"
- a mechanical pencil with plenty of lead
- Highlighters, at least 3 colors
- Red colored pencil with hand sharpener
- 3-4 large & small envelopes or Ziploc bags to organize and store cut out pieces.
- Chunky eraser
- scissors for cutting paper, cutting fabric, cutting small areas and tight curves (embroidery scissors work well here)
- Tweezers
- Tape (masking or painters)
- 2 yards of paper backed fusible web
- 1 dozen safety pins

### These items are suggested, but not required:

- Laptop computer with photo editing software
- 1-3 digital photos of landscapes you love

- Her book, Thread-Painted Portraits
- Design tools (Golden Mean Calipers, Color Filters, Gray Scale Card)
- Free-Motion gloves
- Silicon sewing mat
- Teflon pressing sheet
- Teflon Iron Shoe (protects iron from fusible)
