

Karen G. Fisher's Spiffy Machine Appliqué
April 12, 2018 Workshop

Kit: \$5.00. Extra kits may be purchased

This is a technique workshop. Your finished piece can become the center of a larger design, or you may choose to make more "blocks."

Please bring:

2 - 14" x 14" squares of fabric. Select high contrast fabrics,
either in value or color. Most fabrics will work except really strong prints.

2 - 6" x 6" squares of fabric, same requirements as above

Thread to match OR contrast with your fabric.

Sewing machine in good working order, with blanket/buttonhole stitch. This is a very basic stitch that is included on most multi stitch machines.

It can generally be customized for length and width (make sure you know how).

You will need an open toe or zigzag foot and plate.

THIS IS NOT FREE MOTION WORK.

Also bring whatever supplies you like to have on hand for machine work—lights, extra needles, etc.

Straight pins.

Sharp small scissors for precision cutting appliqué shapes

Paper scissors

Regular pencils (#2) sharpened; mechanical pencils break too easily

You may bring a small iron, but the big ones work best.
