

2016 Christmas Stocking Pattern Instructions

FABRICS: BRIGHT, FUN kids prints for all ages (0-18)

Holiday prints

Liner: Can be solid color (muslin is good)

Cuff: Contrasting fabric

For the Stocking:

Cut 2 stockings out of print

Cut 2 stockings out of liner

Cuff: cut two pieces 8.5" x 3.5"

Alternate: Cut one piece 8.5" x 7", FOLD

Use 1/4" seam, clip curves

With right sides together, stitch stocking sections together, leaving upper edge open.



Turn right side out; press. Stitch Stocking Lining sections together in same manner. With Wrong sides together, pin lining to stocking. Baste raw edges together.



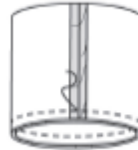
Fold 1/2"-inch wide ribbon in half to form loop; baste ends together.



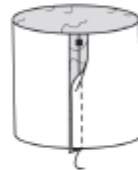
On inside, pin loop to upper edge of stocking, centering over center back seam; baste.



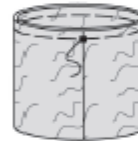
Stitch ends together of each cuff section.



With right sides together, pin cuff sections together, matching seams. Stitch along lower edge.



Turn right side out; press. Baste raw edges together.



Pin cuff to wrong side of stocking, matching front and back seams. Stitch upper edges together, easing in fullness where necessary. Turn cuff to outside; press. **YOU'RE DONE!**
