“O” and “P” Stand for Onions and Pizza

I went back to the “food” fabrics box for both of these. There were other onion fabrics, and other pizza fabrics as well, but I liked these best. There were also oranges and peaches, but I decided to go with spicy.

I have made a few food-themed pieces over the years, and like all themed fabrics, they go in and out of fashion over time. When I made my classroom quilt years ago, I found a whole group of chiles, and I know I’ve had tacos and avocados, and corn, and ice cream, and lots of fruit and chocolates in fabric. I made my husband a shirt in hot sauce fabrics, as well as a barbecue one. He liked the hot sauce but not the barbecue.

I also made a small quilt which I named “Chicken Pot Pie.” It had all the ingredients and cooking tools shown including the chickens, and a plate with a pie and fork. It was a quick seller in the Small Quilt Auction that year.

Both patterns are reversed already for easy tracing onto interfacing or the back of your fabric. Enlarge the patterns 150% for a 10” block.
