


Tucson Quilt Guild Block of the Month Block 6 –

Kansas City Star Quilt Pattern Collection; Published April 1930 Single Wedding Ring –

That variation of the Wedding Ring quilt, both single and double, were popular in grandmother’s day is attested by this pattern of the single Wedding Ring Block that has over 90 years of history behind it. This lovely old-time block was contributed to the Star by Miss Margaret Ballard 4138 Michigan Ave, who says it has been in her family since the early part of the last century. A cousin of Miss Ballard living near Kingsville, MO has the original quilt. Printed patches of gingham make an attractive block as do a combination of pastel on a plain background.



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

background		Color(s)	
5	2 ½” square	4	2 ½” square
8	3” square (HST)	8	3” square (HST)

FINISH Make 16 HST from the 3” squares Trim to 2 ½” square Layout pieces according to diagram in original above and stitch together If you press each row in opposite directions, then you can nest seams Block size 10 ½” unfinished, 10” finished
