

# TQG BLOCK of the MONTH

**Block 9** - Kansas City Star Quilt Pattern Collection; Published March 1929 Goose in the Pond – Goose in the Pond is one of those old-fashioned names attached to many patchworks. It is composed of twenty-five 3-inch squares; five of them plain, twelve made of two triangles, four tiny nine patches and four 3-layer strips. These make a block 15 inches square. Set together with strips 3 inches wide and tiny nine patches at the corners. It takes about sixteen blocks with borders to make a quilt; a wider border at top and bottom of course. Cut the cloth a seam longer than the four patterns given here and there is a good pattern for a patchwork pillow or tie in chair seat covers.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS – BG = background

### 9 -Patches

Color 2 (Gold)	2, 1 ½ X 7
Color 2 (Gold)	1, 1 ½ X 13
BG (white)	1, 1 ½ X 7
BG (white)	2, 1 ½ X 13

### Bars

Color 2 (Gold)
BG (white)

### HST

Color 1 (Green)	6, 4” Sq
BG (white)	6, 4” Sq

### Ctr Sq & Ctr sides

5, 3 ½ Sq

2, 1 ½ X 15
1, 1 ½ X 15

## FINISH

### 9 Patches Make 4

- 1 - Using 2 BG (white) & 1 color 2(gold) 1 ½ x 13 make a strip set white, gold. White
- 2 - Using 1 BG (white) & 2 color 2(gold) 1 ½ x 7 make a strip set gold, white, gold
- 3 - Cut all strip sets to 1 ½ inches square
- 4 - Piece rows 1 of each - strip set 1, strip set 2, strip set 1

### Bars Make 4

- 1 - Using 1 BG(white) & 2 color 2(gold) 1 ½ x 15 make a strip set gold, white, gold
- 2 - Cut each strip set to 3 ½ long

### HST – Make 12

- 1 - Using color 1 (green) & BG 4” sq make HST
- 2 - Trim 3 ½ sq

### Finishing

- 1 - Piece using layout in diagram above
- 2 - block is 15 ½” unfinished, 15” finished

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
