

TQG BLOCK of the MONTH

TQG BOM 4 (January, 2026) 12.5"

Colors:

C1 Butter

C2 Orange (not used this month)

C3 Blue


C4 Red

C5 Brown

Lightest



Darkest



HINT: I use starch when working with bias/diagonal seams.

1. Center:

- ✓ Cut one each 7" square C5 (Brown) and C3 (Blue)
- ✓ Make one HST and trim to 6.5"
- ✓ (will be left with extra hst-perhaps for your back label?)



2. Corner Squares

- ✓ Cut two 4.25" squares C1 (butter)
- ✓ Cut one each 4.25" square C4 (red) and C5 (brown)
- ✓ Sew HSTs C1/C4 and C1/C5
- ✓ Trim to 3.5" for corner squares




3. Rectangle HRTs

- ✓ Cut six 4.25" x 3.25" rectangles C1(butter)
- ✓ Cut two 4.25" x 3.25"rectangles C4 (red)
- ✓ Cut two 4.25" x 3.25"rectangles C3 (blue)
- ✓ Cut two 4.25" x 3.25"rectangles C5 (brown)
- ✓ For the sets C1/C4: Take the C4s(red) lay lengthwise in front of you right side up then twist one of the C1(butter) sideways so opposite corners match and twist the other C1 sideways on the other C4 *the opposite way*.
- ✓ Mark center seam corner to corner and sew 1/4" from corner to corner just like with an HST
- ✓ Repeat for remaining rectangle sets of C1/C3 and C1/C5
- ✓ Trim all to 3.5" to 2.5" lining up the ruler so the seam comes to the points with the sewn line



4. Sew together per picture.



Take care:

It's really easy to turn the blocks the wrong way on this one. Check twice and sew once. 😊
