


TQG BLOCK of the MONTH

TQG BOM 5 (February, 2026) 12.5"

Colors:

- C1 Butter
- C2 Orange
- C3 Blue
- C4 Red
- C5 Brown

Lightest
↓
Darkest



💡 HINT: I use starch when working with bias/diagonal seams.

1. Center:

- Cut one 2.5" square of C2 (Orange)
- Cut strip 2.75" x 19" strip C5 (Brown),
- Sew C5 sew as a log cabin around the center orange
- Trim to 6.5"


2. Corners:

- Cut eight 2" squares of C1 (Butter)
- Make Corner HST :
 - Cut four 3" inch squares of C3 (Blue) and of C1 (Butter) match right sides together.
 - Make HSTs: Sew ¼" from center on each side. Trim to 2"
 - Carefully line up and sew HSTs to corner squares trim blocks to 3.5"



3. Outside Centers: Be gentle there is lots of bias sewing

- Cut 4.5" square of C1 (Butter). Cut in quarters diagonally.
- For C3 (Blue) strips cut a 1.5" strip width of fabric – or two strips ~20" each
- For each C1 (Butter) triangle, sew a strip of C3 (Blue) to the short edge of C1 (Butter) leaving enough at the bottom to trim even with C1. Repeat on other side. Trim to a right angle (90 degree) triangle 3.5" high.
- Cut four 4.25" squares of C4 (Red). Cut in half diagonally.
- Sew long side of C4 triangles to the short sides of C3/C1 combo triangle lining up the long bottom edge so the red overlaps on the pointed side
- Trim combo rectangles to 6.5" wide by 3.5" tall
- Note there will be overlap of red above the floating C1 triangle



4. Sew block together as per picture
