

TQG BLOCK of the MONTH

TQG BOM 8 (May, 2026)

Colors:

C1 Butter
C2 Orange
C3 Blue
C4 Red
C5 Brown

Lightest



Darkest



💡 HINT: I use starch when working with bias/diagonal seams.

CUT:

Cut for Squares:

- Cut ten 2.5" C3 (Blue) and C2 (Orange) squares
- Cut twenty 2.5" C5 (Brown) squares

Cut for HSTs (Cut all 3.5") trim if needed to 2.5

- Cut 10 squares from C4 (red),
- Cut 20 squares from C3 (blue),
- Cut 35 squares C5 (brown)
- Cut 45 squares C1 (butter)

For horizontal straight edge:

- Cut 15 squares 4.25" C1 (Butter) cut into quarters diagonally twice (long edge is straight of grain)

SEW:

1. Make 10 sets of C4 (Red)/C1 (Butter)
2. Make 10 sets of C5 (Brown)/C3 (Blue)
3. Make 10 sets of C3 (Blue)/C1 (Butter)
4. Make 25 sets of C1 (Butter/C5 Brown)
5. With each set above sew HSTs and cut diagonally

NOTE: Inset Edging Blocks- These directions for making ALL 10 BLOCKS, to make just one, divide by 10.

For each set sew columns/rows then sew together. Baste 1/8" from wide edge to stabilize bias edges
