

## 4-Patch Medallion for Baby

8" Blocks, 4" Borders

42" x 42"

### Kit contains:

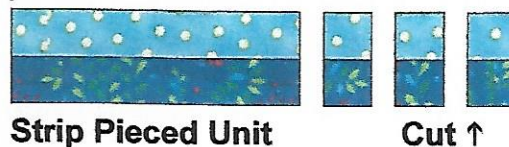
1 yard Light  
1 yard Medium  
1/3 yard Dark  
45" x 45" Backing

### Cutting:

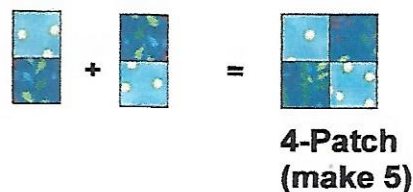
Light – Cut one strip 18" x WOF and cut into 2 18" squares  
(Cut each 18" square diagonally once, to make triangles; need 4)  
Light – Cut one strip 8½" x WOF and cut into 8½" squares (need 4)  
Dark – Cut two strips 4½" x WOF  
Medium – Cut six strips 4½" x WOF (Label 4 of them "Borders")

### Make 4-Patches: (Use ¼" seams)

Strip piece a Dark and a Medium strip together lengthwise to make a Strip Pieced Unit. Make two Strip Pieced Units. Cut them into 4½" segments (need 10).

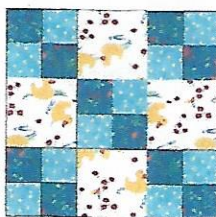


Use two of these segments to make each 4-Patch.  
Make five 4-Patch blocks.



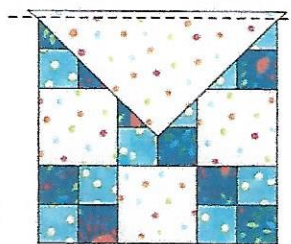
### Center Medallion:

Make the 9-Patch using 5 4-Patch blocks and 4 plain 8½" Light squares.  
Keep the dark squares all lined up, going in the same direction, as shown.

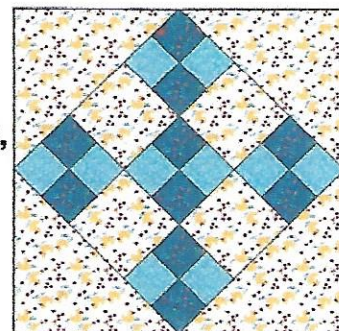


← 9-Patch

Using a ¼" seam, sew the long side of one of the 4 large Light triangles to one side of the 9-Patch, right sides together, and centering it so an equal amount hangs over at each end of the seam. Press seam allowances toward the triangle. Sew another triangle to the opposite side, then sew the remaining two triangles to the other two sides.



Press, and if necessary, trim to straighten the outer edges of the medallion, leaving at least ¼" seam allowance at the midpoint of each side, beyond the point where the two light triangles meet.



### Borders:

Measure length of quilt top (from top to bottom). Cut two border strips that measurement. Pin and stitch them to the sides of the quilt top. Press seams toward borders.

Measure width of quilt top from side to side (including the two borders you just added) and cut two border strips that measurement. Pin and stitch them to the top and bottom edges of the quilt. Press seams toward borders.
