

Painting on Fabric with Inks

Supply List

- Pencil and notebook for taking notes
- An ultra fine Sharpie marker to write on ink bottles/pens
- No less than 1/2 yard PFD (Prepared for Dying) white fabric * (you can wash and iron plain white fabric if necessary)
- Approx a fat quarter of white or off-white scrap fabric for practice.
- Fabric scissors
- Masking or painter's tape
- 1 smooth large white plastic trash bag (like for tall kitchen cans)
- A white plastic picnic plate for mixing inks (optional)
- Selection of colors of your choosing of Tsukineko inks in small bottles (available during class time)
- Tsukineko Fantastix painting sticks (available during class time).
- Paper towels (just a few)
- If you already own fabric markers, bring them.

Optional :

- Of the size you wish to paint...A Basic line drawing (coloring book simplicity) of an item you would like to paint. See EZ Drawing button left side panel.
- You might want to keep this first project manageable in size... i.e. around 20" x 20" or smaller.
- I will have several choices of drawings available, so only bring something if you want.

Inks, fantastix painting sticks, and markers will be available in class with arrangements with the hosting organization.
