## JUNE 2020

### POM CHAIR NEEDED

This month's POM brought to you by Marie Morris

You will need Half-square triangles for this block that are 3½" unfinished.

#### Half-Square Triangles

This is how I make them.

1. Take a background square, 4½" x 4½". Draw a diagonal on wrong side from one corner to the other. **Figure A**
2. Place, color square (4½" x 4½") and background square right sides together. Stitch ¼" from drawn line. **Figure B**
3. Set seam and cut on drawn line. You now have two half-square triangles.
4. Press to the dark side. **Figure C**
5. They will be larger than 3½" so you need to square them up to 3½"






This is not a new block but it is a fun block.

#### Contrary Wife

Use at least 3 fabrics in addition to your background fabric.

1. Make four half-square triangles with one color fabric and your background.
2. Cut three squares from a second color, 3½" x 3½".
3. Cut two squares from a third fabric, 3½" x 3½".
4. Assemble rows following diagram.
5. Press
  - a. Top row: Away from middle
  - b. Middle row: Towards middle
  - c. Bottom row: Away from middle
6. Assemble block
