- 3. You may use any colors.

- 4. The quilt should measure no more than 100 inches around the perimeter. Any shape of that dimension is acceptable.
- 5. The quilt must have a hanging sleeve and a label containing the quilt maker's name and title of the quilt. Quilts must also be contained in a cloth bag (pillowcase) to protect them from dirt or damage.
- 6. Your application (including a photo of your quilt) is due by December 1st 2023.
- 7. Drop off at St. Francis Cabrini Church, at the February 2024 meeting.
