KIDS ROW QUILT ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

Tucson Quilt Fiesta 2024

- 1. Kids must be 17 years old or younger to participate in Kids Row.
- 2. There is no fee to participate in Kids Row. Participants will also receive a free Quilt Fiesta admissions wristband to give to an accompanying adult or use themselves, if they are over 14 years old.
- 3. You must attach a 4" x 6" printed photograph of your quilt to your Entry Form. Attach the "KIDS ROW ENTRY PICTURE LABEL" (page 5), to the back of your photograph, and attach the photograph to the upper left corner of the Entry Form.
- 4. All entries must be available to hang EVERY day of the Quilt Fiesta: February 23, 24, 25, 2024.
- 5. All work on the quilt must be done by the child. (Adults may provide age-appropriate assistance if needed.)
- 6. ENTRY FORM DUE DATE: <u>Wednesday</u>, November 15, 2023. Quilts do not need to be finished by the entry due date. A reasonable photo of your planned quilt and measurements, is all that is required. (See Entry Form details on page 3.)
- 1. Multiple entries may be accepted if space is available. Please number your first display choice with Priority "1", "2", etc. Each quilt entered must have a separate entry form.

2. PREPARE YOUR QUILT FOR DROP OFF:

- a. Your quilt must be clean of dirt, lint, odors, and pet hair.
- b. Quilts must have a sleeve on the back for hanging purposes (see page 4 for directions).
- c. Fill out and sew the "KIDS ROW QUILT ID TAG" to the back side of the quilt, on the bottom left corner (see page 4).
- d. Place your quilt in an appropriately sized cover bag that best fits your quilt without being too tight or too loose. Cover bags must be open on one end (think pillowcase style). *One quilt per bag.* See page 7 for instructions on how to make a Quilt Cover Bag.
- e. Fill out and sew the "KIDS ROW COVER BAG ID TAG" to your cover bag at the center of the open end (see page 6).
- 7. **DROP OFF YOUR QUILT BY:** Friday, February 2, 2024 at a participating Quilt Shop. (Please remember to thank the quilt shop staff for holding your Kids Row Entry Quilt.):

- 1. Cut or piece together a piece of muslin or other fabric that is 8 ½ inches by the width c. your quilt.
- 2. Turn a 1" hem to the outside at each end and machine stitch.
- 3. Fold the 8 ½" piece in half lengthwise with the end hems on the outside. Sew a ¼" seam along the raw edges. DO NOT TURN.
- 4. Press the sleeve so that the raw edges of the seam are facing the back of the quilt.
- 5. Pin the sleeve across the back below the binding. The sleeve should now measure 4" in height.
- 6. Whip stitch the sleeve to the back of the quilt, across the top and the bottom of the sleeve. Be careful that your stitches do not go through to the front of the quilt.
- 7. When your quilt is hung, the rod will go through the sleeve and not between the sleeve and the back. The rod will not catch, since the hems are facing outside, and the seam is facing the back.
- 8. Cut out and sew the Kids Row Quilt ID Tag (see next page) to the back of the quilt, LOWER LEFT CORNER.


Cut out and sew this label to the lower left corner of the back side of your quilt.

Cut out and sew this label to the open edge of your quilt cover bag as shown below:



......How to make a quilt bag cover that fits just right......

1. If your quilt is large, fold your quilt in half, top to bottom together. Then fold in half again. If your quilt is small, you may be able to lay it flat without folding it.

2. Measure around your folded quilt. Include an extra 2 inches in each direction.

3. Leave at least 4 inches on the side that will be open. Cut your fabric.

4. Sew on 3 sides with a 1/4 or 1/2 inch seam.

5. The last side left open should be finished with 1/4 inch folded twice, and edge stitched. This will protect your quilt entry.

6. Center and stitch your Cover Bag ID Tag to one of the open edges of your quilt bag.

Please make sure your quilt bag is not too large or too small. Your quilt should be able to slide in and out without difficulty.
