Quilt Fiesta New Member Challenge Entry Form

Part of your new member orientation packet includes about a Fat Quarter piece of fabric -- usually one that is, shall we say, less than inspiring -- to use as you choose in a New Member Challenge quilt. This is your first opportunity to show your creativity and quilting style! See below for the rules:

- The completed quilt must be a maximum of 120" around its perimeter. A wall hanging size quilt in any shape you create, as long as it does not exceed 120".
- The quilt may be pieced, appliqued, or embellished, as long as it has 3 layers (top, batting, and backing) with the layers secured together.
- You must use the fabric you received in your New Member Packet. The fabric must be recognizable! Place a swatch of the fabric on the back of your quilt so we all know what to look for.
- Turn your quilt in to the Membership Director at the November guild meeting. *Please, do not forget to include your entry form.*
- The quilts will be judged by the attendees at the December and/or January Guild meetings.
- All quilts will be shown at the Quilt Fiesta in February, 2023. Quilts will be available for pickup at the end of the show or arrangements can be made to deliver them to an alternate location.
- All quilts must be labeled, include a hanging sleeve (see the guild website for <u>instructions on</u> <u>making a sleeve</u>), and must be received in a pillowcase or cotton bag with this identification securely attached:
