

2025 TUCSON QUILT FIESTA

KIDS ROW INSTRUCTIONS AND ENTRY

- 1. Entrants (kids) must be 18 years old or younger to participate in Kids Row.
- 2. There is no entry fee.
- 3. You must attach a 4 x 6-inch photograph or drawing of your quilt to your Entry Form (page 2).
- 4. Attach the provided Kids Row Photo Label ID Tag (page 3) to the back of your photograph or drawing.
- 5. Each entry/quilt requires a separate Entry Form.
- 6. All work on the quilt must be done by the child, however, adults may provide guidance and assistance that is appropriate to the age of the child.
- 7. Quilts must have a 4-inch sleeve on the back for hanging purposes (see page 4 for instructions).
- 8. ENTRY FORMS DUE DATE: Saturday, October 12, 2024
 - a. Quilts do <u>not</u> need to be finished by this date. A reasonable photo or drawing of your planned quilt with measurements, is all that is required with the Entry Form.
 - b. Mail to <u>either</u> Joyce Harrison <u>or</u> Kate Clark. See below for addresses.
- 9. QUILT DROP-OFF DUE DATE: Wednesday, December 18, 2024
 - a. Attach the Kids Row Quilt ID Tag (page 3) to the back of the quilt, lower left corner.
 - b. Place your quilt in an appropriately sized cover bag that best fits your quilt without being too tight or too loose (See page 5 for instructions).
 - c. Cover bags must be open on one end (think pillowcase style).
 - d. Attach the Cover Bag ID Tag (page 3) to the outside of the cover bag, at the center of the opened end.
 - e. All quilts and cover bags must be clean of dirt, lint, odor, and pet hair.
 - f. You must drop off your quilt(s) at your selected quilt shop indicated on the Entry Form. See the Entry Form for the list of participating shops. Please remember to thank the quilt shop staff for holding your KIDS ROW quilt entry.
- 10. **QUILT FIESTA DURATION:** January 10-12, 2025. All entries must be available to hang EVERY day of the Quilt Fiesta.
- 11. Multiple entries may be accepted if space is available. Indicate your display choice with a Priority number ("1", "2", etc.), on your Entry Form.
- 12. QUILT PICKUP: starting Thursday, January 16, 2025.
 - a. Your quilt will be <u>available for pick up</u> at your chosen quilt shop.
 - b. Included with your quilt will be a ribbon and "thank you" gift for participating in Kids Row!

KIDS ROW - Making a 4 Inch HANGING SLEEVE PLEASE KEEP THIS PAGE FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- 1. Cut or piece together a piece of muslin or other fabric that is 8 ½ inches wide, and as long as the width of the quilt.
- 2. Turn a 1 inch hem to the outside at each end and machine stitch. Fold the 8 ½ inch piece in half lengthwise, with the end hems on the outside. Sew a ¼ inch seam along the raw edges. DO NOT TURN
- 3. Press and position the sleeve so that the raw edges of the seam are facing the back of the quilt. Pin the sleeve across the back below the binding. The sleeve should now measure 4 inches in depth. Whip stitch the sleeve to the back of the quilt, across the top and the bottom of the sleeve. Be careful that your stitches do not go through the front of the quilt.
- 4. When your quilt is hung, the rod will go through the sleeve and not between the sleeve and the back. The rod will not catch, since the hems are facing outside, and the seam is facing the back.
- 5. Cut out and place and sew the Kids Row Quilt Id Tag to the lower **left** quilt back.

.....How to make a quilt bag cover that fits just right.....

- 1. If your quilt is large, fold your quilt in half, top to bottom together. Then fold in half again. Then fold again sides meeting, then again. This reduces your quilt to a controllable shape without causing too many fold marks.
- 2. Measure around your folded quilt. Include an extra 2 inches in each direction.
- 3. Leave at least 4 inches on the side that will be open. Cut your fabric.
- 4. Sew on 3 sides with a 1/4 or 1/2 inch seam.
- 5. The last side left open should be finished with 1/4 inch folded twice, and edge stitched. This will protect your quilt entry.
- 6. Center and stitch your Cover Bag ID Tag to one of the open edges of your quilt bag.

Please make sure your quilt bag is not too large or too small. Your quilt should be able to slide in and out without difficulty.
