Vintage Quilt Entry Form

There will be no specific theme for the 2025 Vintage Quilt Turning.

- 1. "Vintage" quilts are 50 years or older.
- 2. Prepare two 4" x 6" photos of the guilt:
 - One photo of the entire quilt.
 - One close-up photo of a section of the quilt.
 - On the back of both photos, write your name, guild member #, and quilt pattern (if submitting on paper).
 - Attach the photos to the upper left-hand corner of the entry form (if submitting on paper).
 - Please Note: Printed photos will not be returned.
- 3. Please submit your entry form and photos to:

 - On paper, mailed to Ginger Frame, 5890 East Calle Val, Tucson, AZ, 85760 -OR-
 - On paper, directly handed to Ginger Frame or Kathie Gilbert at the September or October Guild meetings.
 - Whichever way you wish to submit your entry, please be sure to submit all the information and pictures as listed above.
- 4. Applications are due by November 1, 2024.

Our goal is to show quilts of varied periods, styles, "best", and "utility, so we may not be able to use all of the submitted quilts. You will know by December if your quilt is selected.

- 5. If selected, you'll be given instructions on labeling your quilt and quilt bag, as well as when and where to pick up your quilt after the show.
- 6. Selected quilts are to be dropped off at the December Guild meetings, either on Tuesday evening or Wednesday morning, to Ginger Frame or Kathie Gilbert.
